 After a 2 year hiatus, we're back on the water! On September 10, 2022, please join The Kentucky Thorough Breasts, our region's Breast Cancer Survivor Dragon Boat Racing Team, as they present the 11th Annual Kentucky Dragon Boat Festival, *Paddling for the Pink*. All monies raised from this festival stay locally to support non-profit Women's Wellness Programs and Organizations. To date, The


 Kentucky Dragon Boat Festival, *Paddling for the Pink*, has donated over \$100,000 to local organizations.

Paddling for the Pink is the only dragon boat festival IN THE WORLD to be hosted and run by breast cancer survivors and supporters. Anyone would be impressed to see breast cancer survivors not only paddle, but steer 50 foot boats weighing over 4,000 lbs. down the course. These women give a whole new meaning to "surviving and thriving".

Community teams from Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky participate in the festival at scenic AJ Jolly Lake in Campbell County KY. They are joined by breast cancer survivor teams from surrounding states for a day of competition and celebration. Each team this year will race down the 250 meter course 3 times during the festival. Teams should be comprised of 18 paddlers, 8 of which need to be women. The minimum age for a paddler is 13. There is still time to register at WWW.P4CA.ORG.
